Instructions

The student's letter must be typewritten and include the following:

- Area of educational interest and future goals
- The name of the school s/he is planning to attend and why
- A statement why s/he is deserving of a scholarship award
- Specific Foundation scholarship(s) applied for (keeping in mind that some require a four year degree program, while another is specific to a particular field of study). A list of available scholarships is attached.

The deadline for application submission is **April 26, 2024**. **Completed applications and letters may be turned in to Mrs. Lori LaRoux in the Superintendent's Office**.

WAYNE K. NESTER SCHOLARSHIP - Number and Amount(s) to be determined annually.

The scholarship awarded will be disbursed over four years for expenses including tuition, room and board and books.

The senior(s) that will qualify for the scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Accepted and plans to enroll in an undergraduate degree program at an accredited college or university.
- 2. Demonstrates financial need.
- 3. Has attended Lake Linden-Hubbell High School for a minimum of 4 consecutive years. (For students in graduating years 2021, 22, and 23, students must have been enrolled before Feb. 2020.)
- 4. Must have maintained good attendance
- 5. Has maintained a GPA of 3.5 or higher
- 6. Must submit at least 2 letters of reference that show involvement in extra-curricular activity as well as community activity.

In order to maintain scholarship funds, the student must:

- 1. Maintain a 2.5 GPA
- 2. Submit a copy of transcript at the end of each semester and a copy of their class schedule or tuition bill for the upcoming semester.
- 3. Maintain a minimum of 12 credits per semester

Failure to make sophomore standing at the end of the summer term of the first academic year will result in loss of the scholarship. Failure to make junior standing at the end of the summer term of the second academic year will result in loss of the scholarship. Recipient must contact the Lake Linden-Hubbell Public Schools Foundation Board in the event of extenuating circumstances.

WAYNE NESTER SCHOLARSHIP - Number and Amount(s) to be determined annually.

Criteria:

- 1. Accepted and plans to enroll in an undergraduate degree program at an accredited college or university.
- 2. Attended LLHHS for two consecutive years.
- 3. Financial need, good attendance and potential for becoming an outstanding student, athlete or otherwise contributing in an outstanding way to academic life.

Payment: Over 4 years (2x per year)

In order to maintain scholarship funds the student must:

- 1. Maintain a 2.0 GPA
- 2. Submit a copy of transcript at the end of each semester and a copy of their class schedule or tuition bill for the upcoming semester.
- 3. Maintain a minimum of 12 credits per semester

WAYNE NESTER SCHOLARSHIP (continued)

Failure to make sophomore standing at the end of the summer term of the first academic year will result in loss of the scholarship. Failure to make junior standing at the end of the summer term of the second academic year will result in loss of the scholarship. Recipient must contact the Lake Linden-Hubbell Public Schools Foundation Board in the event of extenuating circumstances.

JAMES RUPPE SCHOLARSHIP - Number and Amount(s) to be determined annually.

Criteria:

- 1. Accepted and plans to enroll in an undergraduate degree or certified program at an accredited college or university.
- 2. Attended LLHHS for two consecutive years.
- 3. Financial need, good attendance and potential for becoming an outstanding student, athlete or otherwise contributing in an outstanding way to academic life.

Payment: Over 4 years (1x per year)

In order to maintain scholarship funds, the student must:

- 1. Maintain a 2.0 GPA
- 2. Submit a copy of transcript at the end of each semester and a copy of their class schedule or tuition bill for the upcoming semester.
- 3. Maintain a minimum of 12 credits per semester

PHILIP RUPPE SCHOLARSHIP - Two \$2000 awards.

Criteria:

- 1. Accepted and plans to enroll in an undergraduate degree or certified program at an accredited college or university.
- 2. Attended LLHHS for two consecutive years.
- 3. Financial need, good attendance and potential for becoming an outstanding student, athlete or otherwise contributing in an outstanding way to academic life.

Payment: Over 4 years (\$500 payment per year)

In order to maintain scholarship funds, the student must:

- 1. Maintain a 2.0 GPA
- 2. Submit a copy of transcript at the end of each semester and a copy of their class schedule or tuition bill for the upcoming semester.
- 3. Maintain a minimum of 12 credits per semester

JAMES SARAZIN SCHOLARSHIP - \$250 award, one lump sum payment.

Criteria:

- 1. Minimum 2-year program.
- 2. GPA of 3.0 at the time of graduation

JULIE MYERS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$250 award, one lump sum payment.

Criteria: Student pursuing health care profession

LLHHS FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP(S) - Number and Amount(s) to be determined annually

In order to maintain scholarship funds, the student must:

- 1. Maintain a 2.0 GPA
- 2. Submit a copy of transcript at the end of each semester and a copy of their class schedule or tuition bill for the upcoming semester.
- 3. Maintain a minimum of 12 credits per semester

JOHN L. BELAIRE SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 award, one lump sum payment.

MOLLY KUS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP - \$500 award, one lump sum payment.

Criteria:

- 1. Student pursuing a degree in education
- 2. Preference will be given to students graduating with a GPA of 3.5 or higher or demonstrating financial need.

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
