Reconfirm instructional delivery method:

We will deliver instruction to our students face to face. We will also have an online option through a 3rd party vendor for our K-5. For grades 6-12 students have the option of being completely online through 3rd party vendors, choosing Lakes LiveStreaming which allows them to livestream their core classes or Lakes Virtual in which their core classes content is recorded and then uploaded to Google Classroom where the student can access it at their convenience.

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Pre-Kindergarten:
Face to face instruction or completely online via our 3rd party vendor (Lincoln Learning)

Elementary (Grades K - 5):
Face to face instruction or completely online via our 3rd party vendor (Lincoln Learning)

Middle School (Grades 6 - 8):
 Face to face instruction. For grades 6-8, students have the option of being completely online through 3rd party vendors, choosing Lakes LiveStreaming which allows them to livestream their core classes at their normal times or Lakes Virtual in which their core class content is recorded and then uploaded to Google Classroom where the student can access it at their convenience. The rest of their schedule is filled out with options from 3rd party vendors.

High School (Grades 9 - 12):
 Face to face instruction. For grades 9-12, students have the option of being completely online through 3rd party vendors, choosing Lakes LiveStreaming which allows them to livestream their core classes at their normal times or Lakes Virtual in which their core class content is recorded and then uploaded to Google Classroom where the student can access it at their convenience. The rest of their schedule is filled out with options from 3rd party vendors.
