



Lake Linden Hubbell Sportsmen's Association Scholarship

The Lake Linden Hubbell Sportsmen's Association has established a scholarship fund from which a \$1000 scholarship will be awarded each year.

The recipient of the Lake Linden Hubbell Sportsmen's Association scholarship will be selected by the Board of Directors of the Lake Linden Hubbell Sportsmen's Association. The recipient will be selected on the basis of their educational plans, academic achievement, need for financial assistance, areas of civic leadership and any other information the student feels the directors should be informed of to help them in the selection process.

The scholarship will be divided into two payments. The first half of the award will be paid at the start of the first semester, once the student has submitted proof of enrollment (copy of schedule or tuition bill) in a post-secondary program. The second half of the award shall be made available at the start of the second semester. In order to receive the second payment, the student must submit a copy of his/her grade report indicating that a 2.50 college grade point average is being maintained as well as proof of enrollment for the second semester (copy of schedule or tuition bill). Recipient must be enrolled at an institution (college, university, vocational or trade school) that is approved by the Board of Directors for accreditation of the particular type of technical or professional field to be eligible to receive the scholarship payments. Disbursements will be handled by the high school of the student.

Failure on the part of the recipient to meet all the above requirements will result in the remainder of the award reverting back to the Lake Linden Hubbell Sportsmen's scholarship fund.

Instructions

The Lake Linden Hubbell Sportsmen's Association Application must be completed, printed, and signed by the student and submitted along with an accompanying letter of application to the Board of Directors of the Lake Linden Hubbell Sportsmen's Association. The letter and application must be received (not postmarked) no later than April 26, 2016

The student's letter must include the following:

- Area of educational interest and future goals
- The name of the school, she/he is planning to attend and why
- A statement of why she/he is deserving of a scholarship award
