Regular Meeting  
September 9, 2019**

A Regular Meeting of the Lake Linden-Hubbell Schools Board of Education was held in the Boardroom on Monday, September 9, 2019. The meeting was called to order by President Patricia Burton at 5:30 p.m.

Mr. Brad Codere gave a Superintendent's Report on Capital Projects.

Mr. Jack Johnson gave the Elementary Coordinator's Report. Packet Pick-Up was very successful with about 70% of families stopping to get their packet of forms before the start of the school year. Casey Kivikko will be here as the Superior AmeriCorps worker this year. She will work with our 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade classes. Dial Help will be providing counseling services to students in need again this year. The CCISD may also be able to expand services to other students who were previously unable to receive services. The Student Assessment Team (SAT) procedure has been streamlined which will better allow us to serve our students who are struggling. The PBIS Kick-Off Assembly was held on September 6.

Mr. Brad Codere gave a K-12 Principal's Report. The K-12 enrollment number is currently 396.72 which includes a few part-time students. The updated Middle/High School master schedule and elementary paraprofessional assignments were reviewed. The schedule of emergency drills has been submitted to the Emergency Measures Coordinator for the County as well as local fire departments and law enforcement. The first fire drill is

this week. Homecoming festivities will take place the week of September 16. There will be dress up days, crowning of the king and queen, the parade, bonfire and home volleyball and football games.
