

**Lake Linden-Hubbell Public Schools
Board of Education
Regular Meeting
May 11, 2026**

A Regular Meeting of the Lake Linden-Hubbell Schools Board of Education was held in Room 102 of the High School building on Monday, May 11, 2026. The meeting was called to order by President Patricia Burton at 5:30 p.m.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Jennifer Beaudette and supported by Lori Ambuehl to excuse David Anderson from the meeting. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

There were two additions to the agenda. Item number 13-A was a motion to accept a letter of resignation. Item number 13-B was a motion to approve the Superintendent employment contract. There being no other revisions to the agenda, a motion was made by Jennifer Beaudette and supported by Jeff Dennis to accept the agenda. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Lori Ambuehl and supported by Courtney Holzberger to accept the May bills (totaling \$52,118.20), the Treasurer's Report, the minutes of the Regular Meeting held on April 13, 2026 and the minutes of the Board of Education Scholarship Committee meeting held on May 6, 2026. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Jeff Dennis and supported by Courtney Holzberger to establish Tuesday, September 8, 2026 as the first instructional day of the 2026-2027 school year. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Lori Ambuehl and supported by Jennifer Beaudette to approve the correction to NEOLA Policy 2266, Nondiscrimination on the Basis of Sex in Education Programs or Activities, as presented. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Jennifer Beaudette and supported by Lori Ambuehl to approve the 2025-2026 scholarship awards as presented by the Scholarship Committee. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Jennifer Beaudette and supported by Melissa Corrigan to review, discuss and act upon the Copper Country Intermediate School Board of Education proposed budget for 2026-2027 in accordance with Section 624 of the Revised School Code and submit pertinent objections and proposed changes to the budget no later than June 1, 2026 to the Intermediate Board or its Superintendent. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Jennifer Beaudette and supported by Courtney Holzberger to approve Maureen Schick as the 2026 Commencement Speaker. Ms. Schick was a teacher in the Lake Linden-Hubbell Schools for 36 years before retiring in 2024. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Jeff Dennis and supported by Jennifer Beaudette to approve the employment of Alyssa Roose in the position of Varsity Volleyball Coach for the 2026-2027 school year. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Jeff Dennis and supported by Lori Ambuehl to accept the letter of resignation as presented by Amy Maki from her position as Elementary Teacher. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.

A motion was made by Lori Ambuehl and supported by Jeff Dennis to approve the Superintendent employment contract as presented between the Lake Linden-Hubbell Schools and Dr. Emily Geiger. Roll call vote. Motion unanimously carried.
